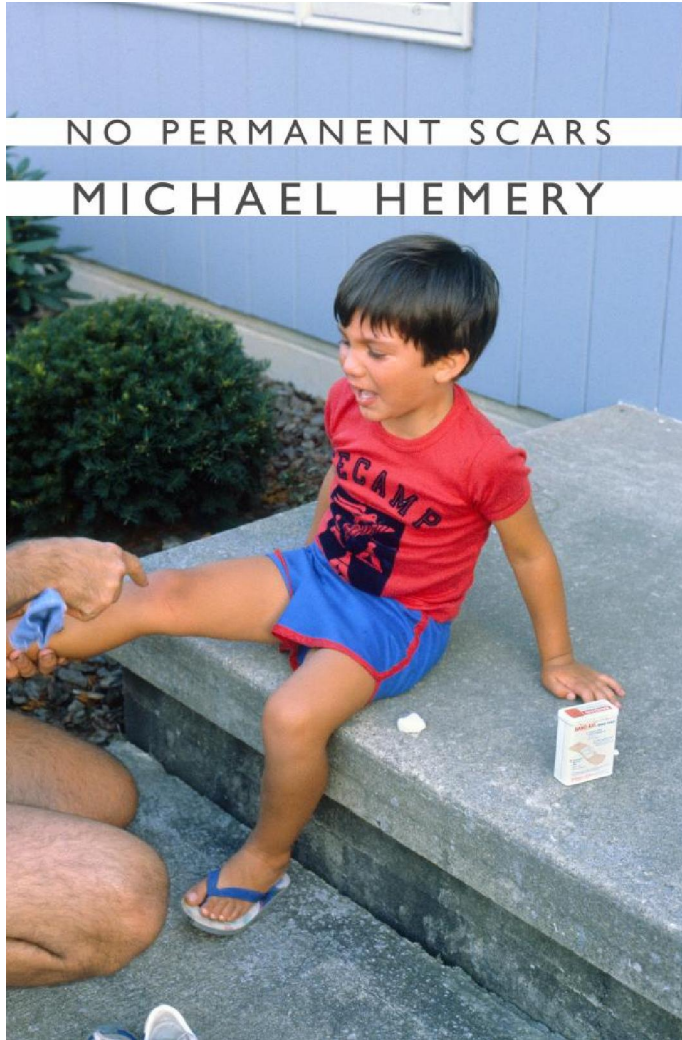


NO PERMANENT SCARS BY MICHAEL HEMERY
